Out of the Past

September 21, 1923

Enrollment in the Crystal Falls District totals 1,756 students for the 1923-24 school year. This total is distributed among the 12 separate school buildings located in the district with pupils attending each school as follows: High School (217), Forest Park Grade School (1,021), Western (108), Tobin (165), Jarvis/Holkup (28), Fisher/Swan Lake (57), Amasa Porter (42), Hemlock (20), Armenia (11), Lind (15), Fortune Lake (34), and Balsam (38). According to regulations, seven or more school age children in an area justified establishment of a school.

Michigan Department of Conservation Deputy Gust Lethin placed 36 pheasants on the Edwards Ranch at Parks Siding during the week. Lethin says that of the pheasants planted last year only the ones that turned out well were placed at the Triangle Ranch. The Triangle squad numbered 36 with 16 surviving into this spring. Since that time a lot of young birds have hatched so that the number in the woods at this point is considerable.
