Out of the Past

Continuing a practice reestablished last year, a Crystal Falls School bus is now transporting children for recreational purposes to Runkle and Fortune Lakes. Monday, Wednesday and Friday the bus leaves the school at 1 PM to Fortune Lake, returning at 5 PM; Tuesday and Thursday to Runkle Lake.
