Deer hunting laws of the State of Michigan as recently enacted: No person shall pursue, hunt or kill any deer save only from November 1st to November 25th; kill at any time a deer when it in its red coat or fawn with sotted coat; kill or capture any deer in the waters of any stream, pond or lake within the jurisdiction of the State of Michigan; use any artificial light when hunting deer; use a dog in pursuing or killing deer and any animal caught doing so may be declared a "public nuisance" and any such animal may be killed by any person with no recourse from the owner of said dog.
