The ongoing issue of zoning along Crystal Avenue again received a public airing at the Crystal Falls City Council meeting. Presently zoned commercial, local residents with homes along the route, which is also designated Hwy US-2, are pushing for spot zoning in hopes of deterring commercial development and continuing to maintain it as a residential neighborhood. No action was taken by the Council with further discussions planned for the future.

The Crystal Falls Public Schools will formerly open for the 1958-59 school year on September 2<sup>nd</sup>.
