Out of the Past

A new garage space for some City of Crystal Falls vehicles is being provided by enclosing the previously open space between the existing garage and shops and the city hall building. City crews had found it necessary to partially dismantle some special equipment in the past because it was impossible to drive into the low clearance bays of the existing garage. The new area will have 14' doors where the special equipment can be stored.

Dr. Douglas Sherk, who has been associated with the Crystal Falls Medical practice since 1963, will be leaving the community later this fall to become associated with a Medical practice in Marquette.
