Out of the Past

In the wake of the plunge reported for 1960 firearm deer season harvest, local Michigan State Legislators Phillip Rahoi , 31st District Senator and Gilbert Wales, Iron District State Representative, have begun to introduce legislation calling for a limit on the Michigan Conservation Commission powers regarding setting special seasons, including antlerless deer as legal game. Local sportsmen argue that the “any deer policy” is the cause for the recent decline in the number of deer killed while the Michigan Department Conservation states that poor winter conditions and loss of deer range is the cause.

The cold, snowless early winter weather has turned most of the area lakes into skating rinks with surfaces like plate glass mirrors. Evidence is included in a photograph of “Puzza” Ellingboe and her daughter Marcia skating across the two-inch thick layer of ice covered with a thin layer of water on Lake Mary.
