Residents of the Kimball Location whose homes are situated on the 40 acre plot of land acquired by the Crystal Falls Tourist Mine Corporation in their dealings with Keweenaw Land Association for the sale of the Kimball Mine, were told at a meeting that they would have an opportunity to purchase the land around their houses. Nearly a dozen home-owners from the location met with representatives of the Tourist Mine operators who informed them that the property will be platted and once the plat is approved by the City of Crystal Falls the Tourist Corporation would be able to sell the land. Since the property in question was held by mineral interest in the past, none of those who own homes in the area had been able to secure ownership of the lots where their homes were situated on.
