Out of the Past

October 9, 1925

Crystal Falls City crews are making improvements to the appearance of the City owned Cemetery. At the entrance two attractive brick pillars set on concrete bases and crowned with concrete caps are installed. A strong steel gate spans the opening between the pillars and on each side of the pillars 100' of strong steel fencing is erected. Next summer it is planned to have the fence continued around the entire perimeter of the cemetery property.

Crystal Falls Schools will be closed Thursday and Friday so the teachers can attend the Michigan State Teachers' Association meeting in Houghton. All 72 teachers of the Crystal Falls School system are members of the Association and 45, more than all other teachers from other Iron County School systems combined, will be travel by private car and school bus to the meeting.

The Hematite School Board, realizing the value of and need for wholesome play for the moral and physical development of youth in Amasa has installed new playground equipment consisting of four wave slides, two 16' & two 20' slides, six swings, trapeze bar, flying rings and three teeters.
