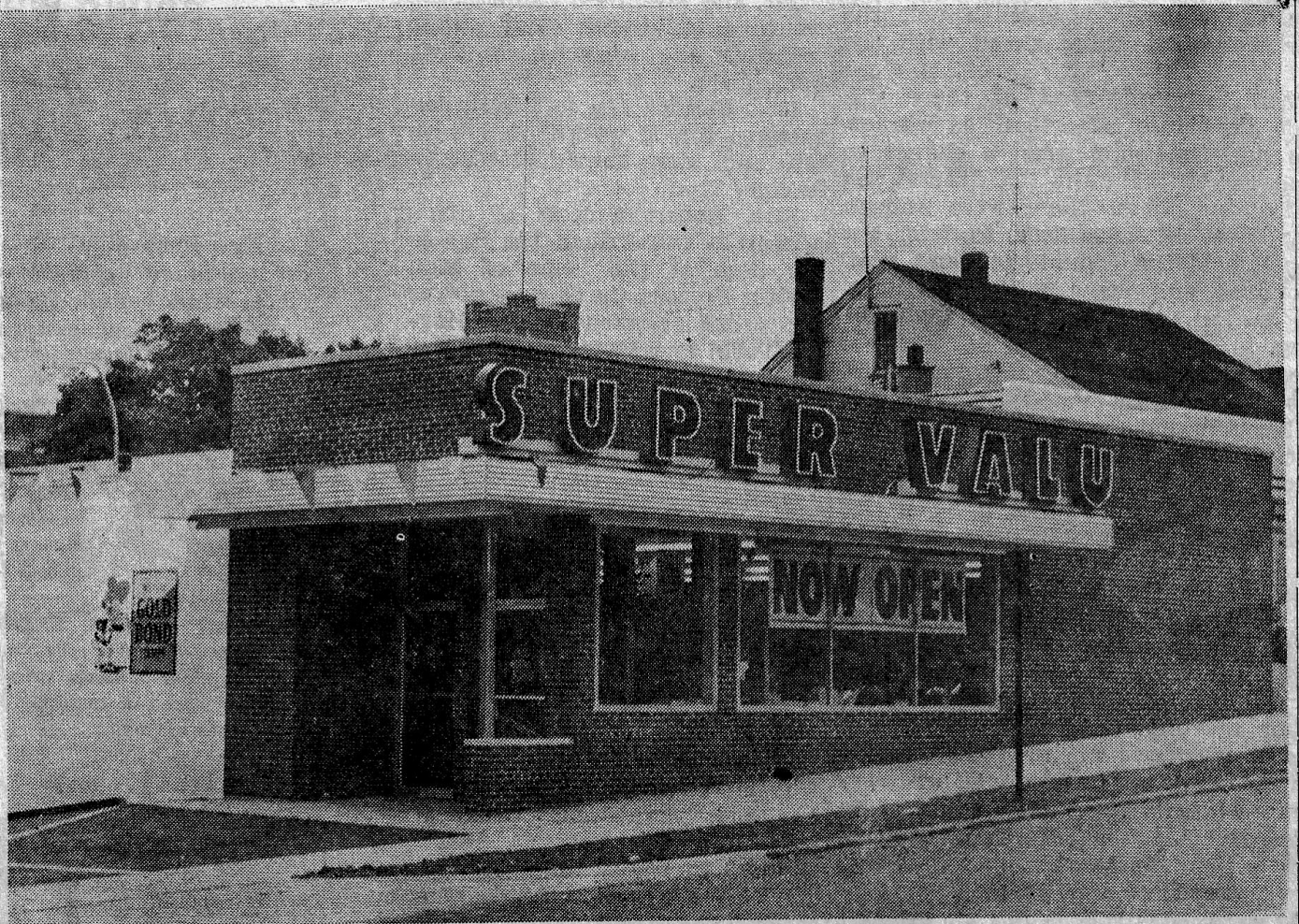
Out of the Past
