The Crystal Falls City Commission has authorized the extension of Park Street to the north. The proposed extension, 44 feet in width, would extend Park Street from its present terminus at Harrison Avenue near the DeMuri house obliquely to the northeast intersecting Briar Hill Street at a point near the A.P. McCowen residence. The extension had been requested by Ballard Dahl who is building a new home north of the DeMuri home. In the early years Briar Hill Street was used as the main thoroughfare out of Crystal Falls to the north passing the Youngstown/Bristol Mine site.
