The Crystal Falls City Commission is considering a new agreement with the Wisconsin-Michigan Power Company which would permit the City to use a maximum demand of 1,000 kilowatts. The present agreement, which expires on March 25, 1951, allows the City to place a demand of 600 kilowatts on the Power Company over the total generated by the City owned power plant at the Falls on the Paint River during high demand occasions. During the past three years the City of Crystal Falls has purchased from the Wisconsin-Michigan Power Company power amounting to \$46,125.
