The prevailing ruling that any Iron County dog that does not have the required dog license and is running free about the area can be killed by local government officials is in jeopardy. A recent Illinois Supreme Court ruling has stated that a dog is classified as personal property which would put a crimp to the practice of exterminating unlicensed animals.
