Out of the Past

The Flood Garage (419 Superior) located on the Southeast corner of Superior Avenue and Fifth Street, has been keeping a record of every out of town vehicle that have stooped at the location to conduct business for the year. A total of 635 vehicles, most of them to purchase gasoline, were led by Wisconsin (179), Illinois (114), Lower Michigan (111) and Minnesota (101).

The work of improvements around the new Amasa School grounds is completed. New concrete walks have been constructed along with extensive grading including a tennis court all according to a landscape plan submitted by a landscape architect from the University of Michigan. Additional playground equipment has been added consisting of swings, teeters, coaster slides, ocean wave and volleyball net.
