

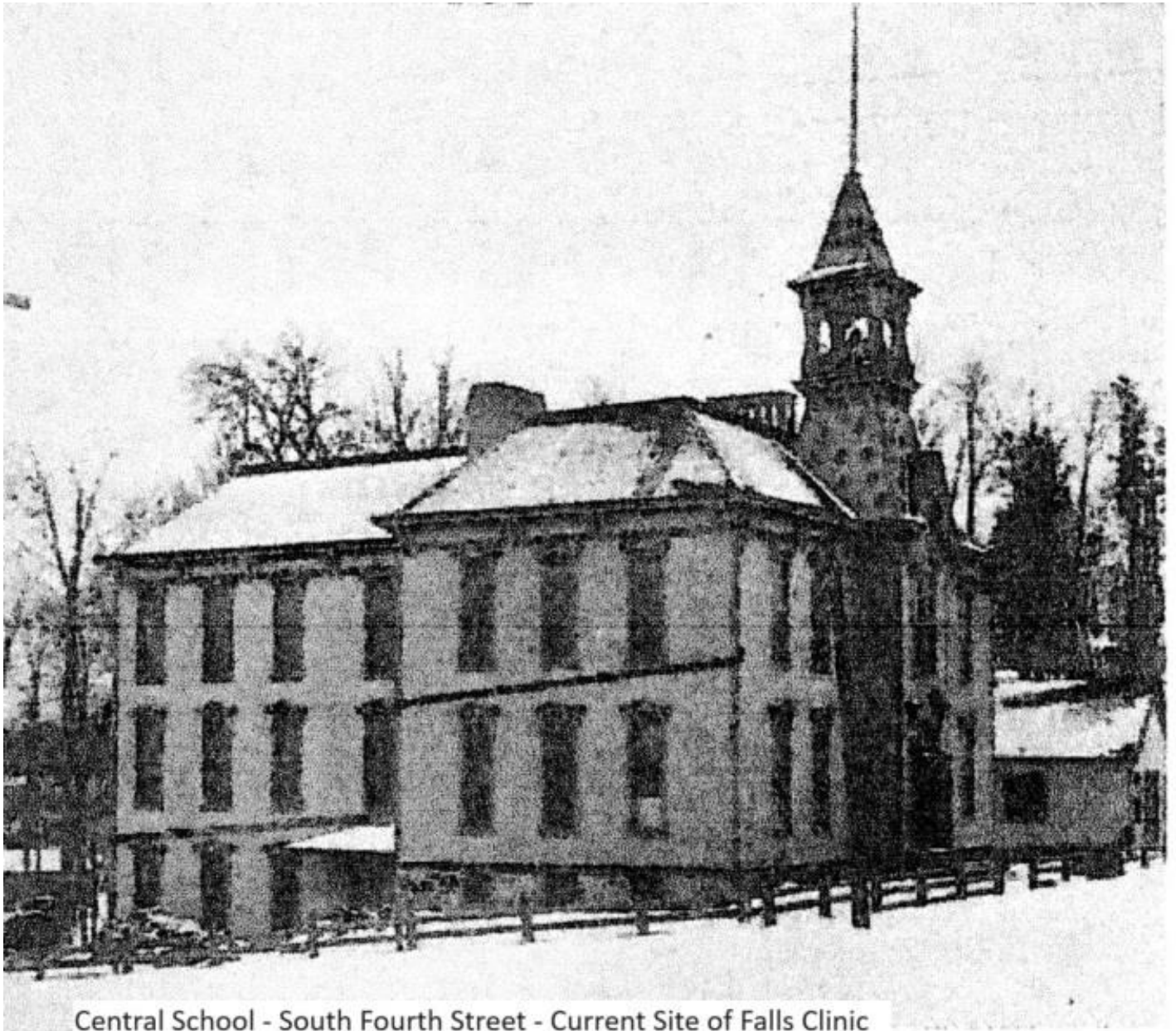

Out of the Past

October 12, 1895

The Chicago & Northwestern Railroad Company wishes to advise the public that effective immediately the Company will pay its bills by use of checks instead of currency. The reason for the change is that it is no longer feasible to guard large amount cash shipments due to the constant menace of reckless train robbers who at times use dynamite and other destructive methods endangering the railroad payment employees. The checks are as good as gold and recipients should be able to cash them at face value at any bank or merchant's store.

Official enrollment figures for the Crystal Falls Schools for the new school year totals 435 students. The Central School (207 S. Fourth Street) has 377 pupils instructed by seven teachers. An overcrowded condition exists at the Central School where there are more students than seats in five of the seven classrooms. The Columbia/Shaffer School has 28 students with Miss Mollie Sweeney as teacher. The Great Western School has 30 students with Miss Behan as teacher.
