Out of the Past

The farming section to the southwest of Amasa lies partly in Crystal Falls Township and partly in Hematite Township. The residents in Crystal Falls Township have been at a disadvantage in getting to Crystal Falls or the Porter Mine due to the fact that they had to go first to Amasa and then back south again. For many years these residents have been asking that a road be built along the town line leading east from the area. Their dream has come true with the completion of a bridge over the Hemlock River completed last year and finishing touches being put on the new road constructed that intersects the County Road about 1.5 mile south of Amasa.
