Crystal Falls City crews began work on the widening of North Fourth Street from Superior Avenue to Crystal Avenue. The existing curbing and sidewalk on the east side of the street will be removed along with the terrace on the west side of the street. The improvements will hopefully eliminate the congestion that results in that area when cars are parallel parked on the east side of the street and angle parked on the west side.

Officials from the Chicago & Northwestern Railroad have issued a warning of poisonous conditions that will exist along the railroad track right-of-way for the next ten days as a result of the company's spraying to kill noxious and unsightly weeds that grow along the tracks. Area residents are advised to stay clear the tracks from the Bristol Mine north of the City to south of the crossing at the bottom of Superior Avenue. Cattle and pets may be affected by the toxic solution and precautions should be taken to keep the animals from entering the contaminated area.
