

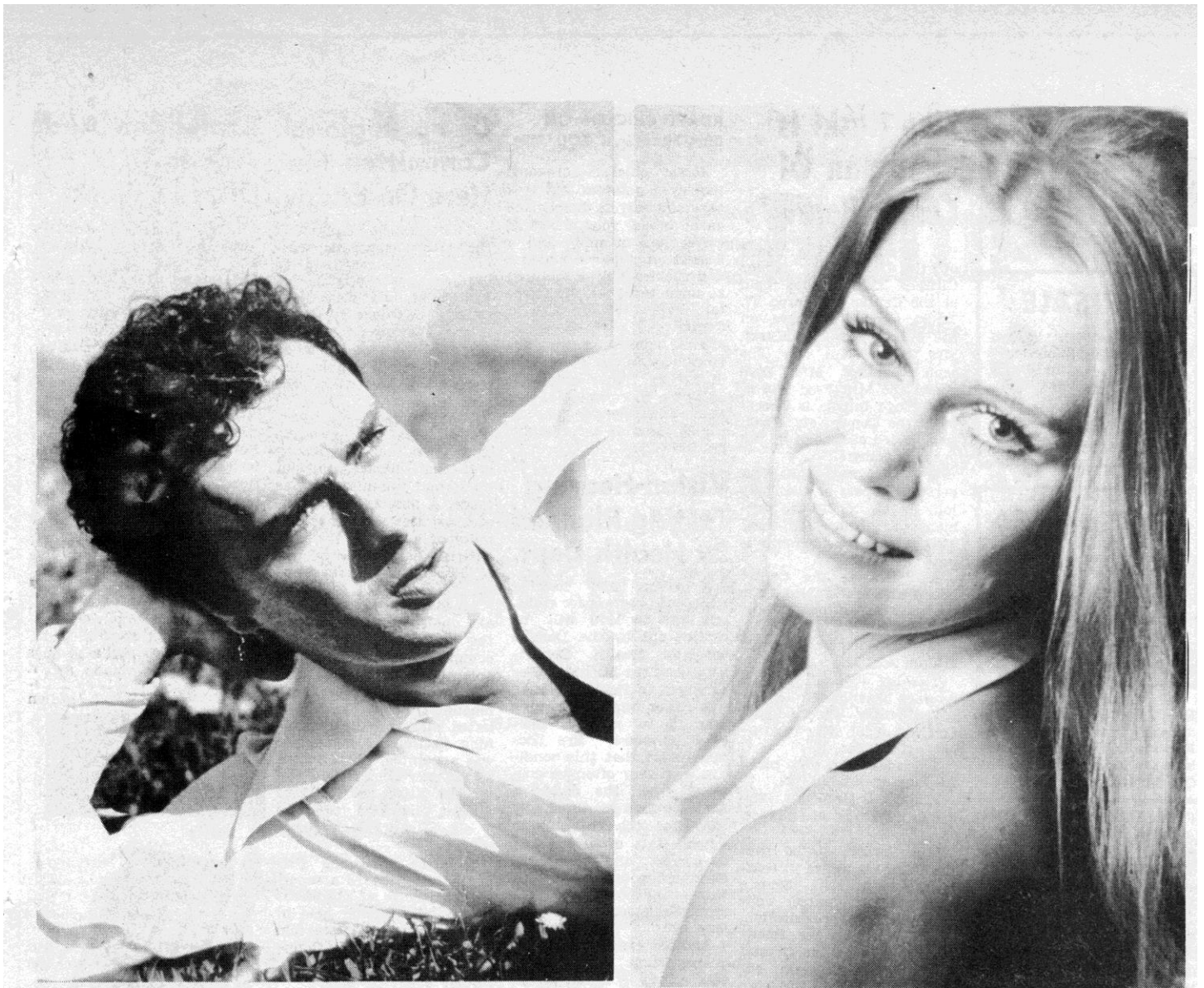
Diamond Drill

Out of the Past

A Crystal Falls area young woman, who launched herself on a career in modeling and entertainment following her studies at the Patricia Stevens Career College in Chicago along with drama and voice in New York City, is busy appearing in films, stage and television productions and commercials. The attractive blond actress, model, dancer and singer was married at her parents' home in December to Michael Hennessey, an actor who majored in theatre at Central Michigan University and has extensive training in classical theatre at Wayne State University.

A total of 57,366 fish were planted in Iron County lakes (38,566) and streams (18,800) during 1973 according to Michigan District fisheries biologist Buddy Jacob. The total was broken down to show brook trout (7,100), brown trout (13,800), rainbow trout (22,950), lake trout (5,000), splake/hybrids (8,221) and northern pike (295). The small number of northern pike were unusual in that they weighed 150 pounds in total and were salvaged as adults from the Presque Isle reservoir drawdown and planted in Smoky Lake.
