Out of the Past

Warren and Tom Davis along with Mike Casanova are partners in the development and operation of the new Davis Mobile Park located off Hwy US-2 just west of Crystal Falls. The 16 site layout on a 36 acre plat just east of the Davis Auto Dine will feature 60' x 90' lots including concrete footings and served by utilities for natural gas, power plus water and sewer.

Carl Brousseau, area forester for the Michigan DNR, laments the unfortunate fact that Dutch elm disease has crept into the area over the past several years. The situation makes every local elm tree a terminal case just awaiting its appointed demise. The local community has a considerable volume of elms but they are scattered with the Crystal Falls Golf Course and School property the most public locations.

Crystal Falls Schools open September 5<sup>th</sup>. Forty five full time teachers and two half-time instructors are on staff for the 1973-74 school year. The non-teaching staff includes seven 12 month employees and 27 school year only employees working shifts from one hour to eight hours per day.
