The Fortune Lake Farmer's threshing machine completed its annual rounds with only 27 farms visited. Last year the machine did 54 jobs and the year before 70 jobs were completed. The machine is steam operated rig and is very inconvenient to use because it burns a lot of wood and necessitates the hauling up to 2,000 gallons of water per day to function.
