

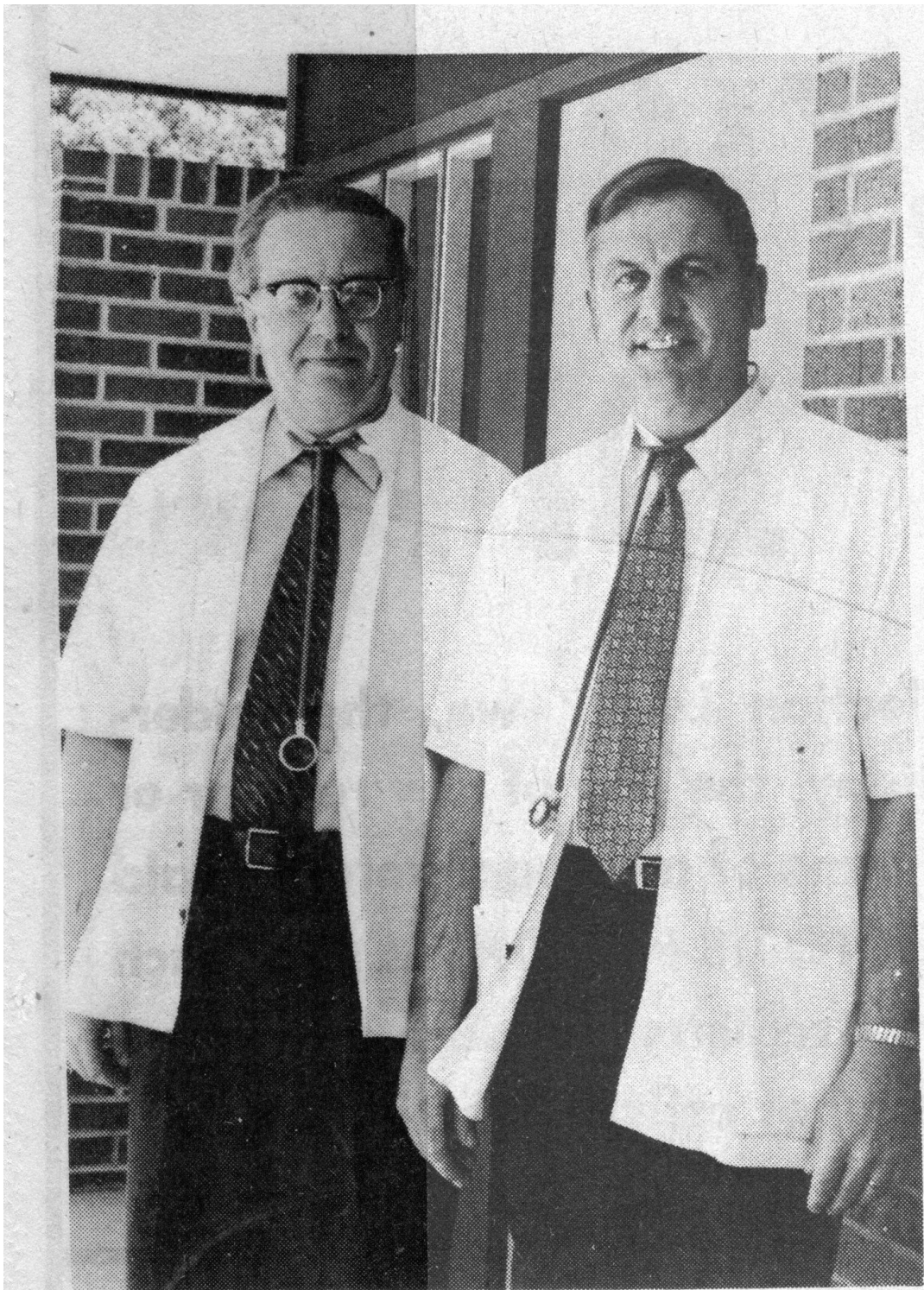

Out of the Past

Dr. Vilis Kruze, a native of Latvia, has joined the Falls Clinic staff in Crystal Falls on a full time basis. Dr. Kruze, board certified in pediatrics, has been practicing medicine in the United States since 1950, most recently at Detroit's Mayberry Clinic. He studied medicine at the University of Latvia in Riga, then under German Military rule during the height of World War II and evacuated the area before the Russian occupation. Kruze brings the number of physicians serving the area to five, a rarity for a community of this size. Other physicians include Dr. E.R. Addison, Dr. R.E. Stelle, Dr. Douglas Sherk and Dr. Frederick Ludwig.

The Bass Festival Committee has announced a change in the route for the annual Bass Festival parade from what has been followed in the past. The mustering area will still be on West Superior Avenue from the Courthouse to Ski Hill Road to the west. Instead of heading north to Crystal Avenue and proceeding east then south on North Fifth Street to Superior Avenue, which obstructs traffic on Hwy US-2, the parade will advance south on Seventh Street, east on Marquette Avenue then north on south Sixth Street to the head of Superior Avenue.
