The Crystal Falls City and Keweenaw Land deal swap is ready for action. The transaction will give the City a 150' strip of land along the north border of the Evergreen Cemetery and Keweenaw will be deeded a strip of the same width on the north end of the airport forty. In addition the City has gained a right of way for a possible extension of Garfield Avenue east from Logan Street to thy Runkle Lake Road. With the proposed new road a new traffic pattern can be established which will end all through traffic on the Runkle Park Road.
