Charlie and Janie Bandaccari have opened a new business venture “Charlie’s Party Store” (300 Superior) in the former Rezin’s Drug Store space. The local couple will provide beer, wine, liquor, bulk cheese, lunch meat, dairy items, candies, magazines, glassware, snack and picnic items. Hours: Monday- Saturday 8AM-11PM, Sunday 9AM-6PM. The building located on the Northwest corner of Superior Avenue and North Third Street has a long history. The structure was built by Crystal Falls pioneer Marcellus J. Lindsay in 1890 and through the years has been referred to as the Lindsay & Ross Building and the Dunn Block. Many businesses have occupied the lower level from grocery stores to the Crystal Falls National Bank. The upper floor has been used as offices by a variety different people.
