Out of the Past

The Michigan State Highway Department has allocated a total of \$4,938.95 for snow removal purposes during the coming winter months. This money is in addition to the gas and license taxes are distributed to Michigan Counties which had 70 or more inches snowfall during the 1957-58 winter season. The distribution formula is based on inches of snowfall multiplied by total road mileage in the County. Both Marquette and Houghton Counties with heavy snowfall each winter, will each receive over \$100,000.

Deer hunters are advised that one deer per hunter per year is the legal limit, regardless of the open season in which the deer is taken. If a hunter bags his deer during the early archery season he is not permitted to hunt for deer during the later firearms season. If the hunter receives a permit to hunt "any deer" during the special seasons, he is still entitled to only one deer, not a buck plus on "any deer".
