Rudolph H. Anderson, 905 Harrison Avenue, Crystal Falls, has retired from his Shift Boss position at the Sherwood Mine after 35 years of service. Rudy started his mining career in 1941 at the Ravenna-Prickett Mine in 1941, moving to the Sherwood as a miner in 1943, transferring to the Cayia Mine as shift boss in 1951, then to the Bristol Mine in 1954 and finally back to the Sherwood in 1956. Inland Steel Company has announced the promotion of Joseph "Toby" Lesandrini, 612 Wisconsin Avenue, Crystal Falls, to the position of Shift Boss at the Sherwood effective March 1st. Toby, a native of Iron Mountain, worked in the CCC Camps (1935-1940) and served in the European Theatre with the Army 89th Infantry Division. After working in various mines in Dickinson and Iron Counties before WWII, he returned to Iron Mountain and was employed by the Iron Mountain Transit Lines before returning as a miner with the Inland Steel Company at the Cayia Mine in 1951, transferring to the Bristol Mine in 1954 and then to the Sherwood in 1956.
