Out of the Past

A crumbling foundation and rusty iron fences, the last evidence of what was once the Western School, disappeared this weekend as a bulldozer cleared away what had become a hazard. Located at the Northwest corner of Wagner Street and Garfield Avenue in the Crystal Falls Western Location the impressive building constructed in 1907 was last used in the late 1920's. The property just south of the golf course's No. 5 green is owned by the Keweenaw Land Association.
