A reminder from the Michigan Conservation Department that with the end of the bow and arrow deer hunting season on November 5th hunters should turn in their kill report cards attached to the back of the licenses. A prompt and completely filled out report from the sportsmen will aid the Department in compiling and interpreting the results for the season.

Well drillers from the Layne Northwest Company have started work on the development of a water supply well for Crystal Falls Township. The well is located six miles north of Crystal Falls on the Alex Aho Farm (NE of NW, Section 1, T43N R33W) near Highway 141. Selected by the Crystal Falls Township Board, the site is situated at the highest point in the Township with hopes of constructing a water tank when funds become available. For years area residents have hauled water from wells on their properties, many for several blocks.
