The Forest Park School Board of Education has decided to memorialize the late Eddie Chambers by naming the new high school gymnasium in his honor. Following considerable discussion relating to the falsely stated information that the districts of Alpha and Amasa were not affected by Chambers, thus not justifying the name change, it was pointed out that Chambers' prominence and influence as coach, athlete, educator and referee was Upper Peninsula wide.

William Way, involved in the shooting and abduction in the local area last month, pleaded guilty to various counts of kidnapping and other crimes was sentenced in Federal Court to three consecutive life terms in prison thus insuring that Way would never be able to walk the streets again as a free man.

Crystal Falls Township contracted with the Iron County Road Commission for complete reconstruction of a portion of Ski Hill Road north of Forest Avenue.
