The Crystal Falls Schools opened on Thursday September 7<sup>th</sup> with a slight increase in enrollment this year (836) over last year (825). This year's pre-kindergarten through sixth grade was 499 versus 495 last year; Junior High (121/116); High School (216/214). Individual class totals: Pre-K (19/8); Kindergarten (63/76), First Grade (53/83); Second (82/71); Third (75/58), Fourth (55/75); Fifth (80/70); Sixth (72/66); Seventh (63/57); Eighth (58/59); Ninth (58/60); Tenth (58/51); Eleventh (48/52) and twelfth (52/51). These figures include 38 tuition students who are being transported from the Mansfield Township School District and are enrolled in grades Pre-K through twelfth grade.

A jellied Swedish meat loaf with emphasis on color and taste is made with ready to serve liver sausage. Liver sausage is rubbed through a sieve and combined with mayonnaise, dry mustard, chopped celery, green pepper and onion. The mixture is added to slightly congealed tomato-flavored gelatin and placed in a ring mold and refrigerated till firm then served on a bed of shredded lettuce lightly sprinkled with paprika.
