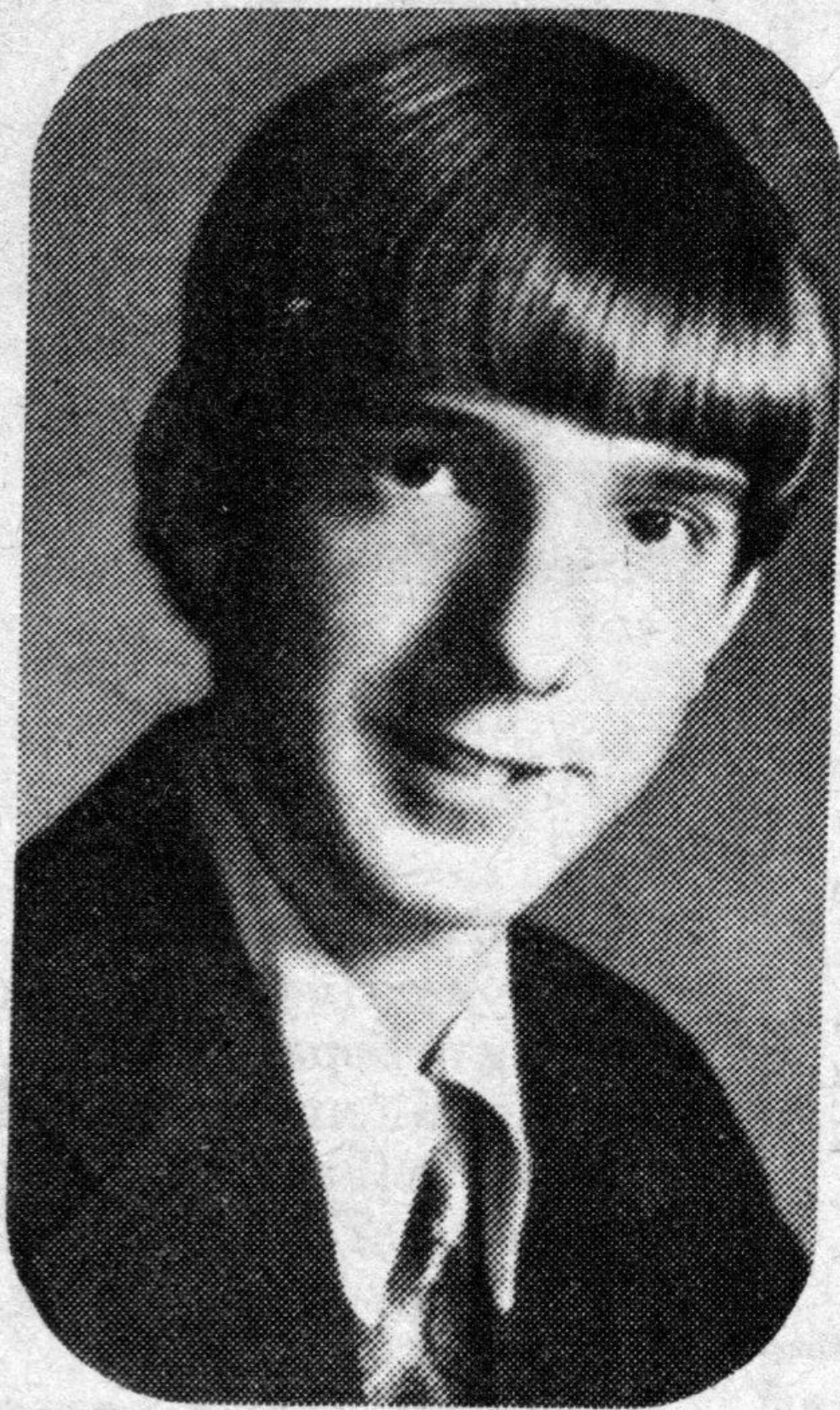
Out of the Past

Iron County's over-65 population is growing in importance – numerically, economically and politically. The latest figures show that this age group has been one of the fastest growing with 1 out of every 6 persons locally now 65 or older. Nationally there are now more than 22 million persons in that age bracket representing 10 percent of the total population. In Iron County this age group represents 16.6 percent of the citizens.

Dawson Lake, in Mansfield Township, was treated six years ago in preparation for planting trout, being successful up to a point. It did create limited good trout fishing but minnows, suckers and bullheads eventually became dominant. The Michigan DNR has again applied a new poison treatment with hopes of planting trout and largemouth bass in the lake as soon as the water detoxifies.
