Out of the Past

The Crystal Falls City Council recently adopted a new ordinance governing the overnight parking on City Streets between November 1st and May 1st. Under the terms of the ordinance no person shall, between the hours of 2:00 AM and 7:00 AM, park a motor vehicle on any public street or alley. Adopted to simplify the Street Department's snow plowing, the Crystal Falls Police Department has issued 35 tickets for violations during the first week of enforcement.

A formal grand opening was held for the new Chevrolet Agency, absent from Crystal Falls since the fall of 1941. The agency established by E.W. and R.H. Anderson owners of the Anderson Motor Company of Iron Mountain and Norway, is housed at the Ahlberg Implement Building (45 Superior). John B. Anderson, son of E.W.
