

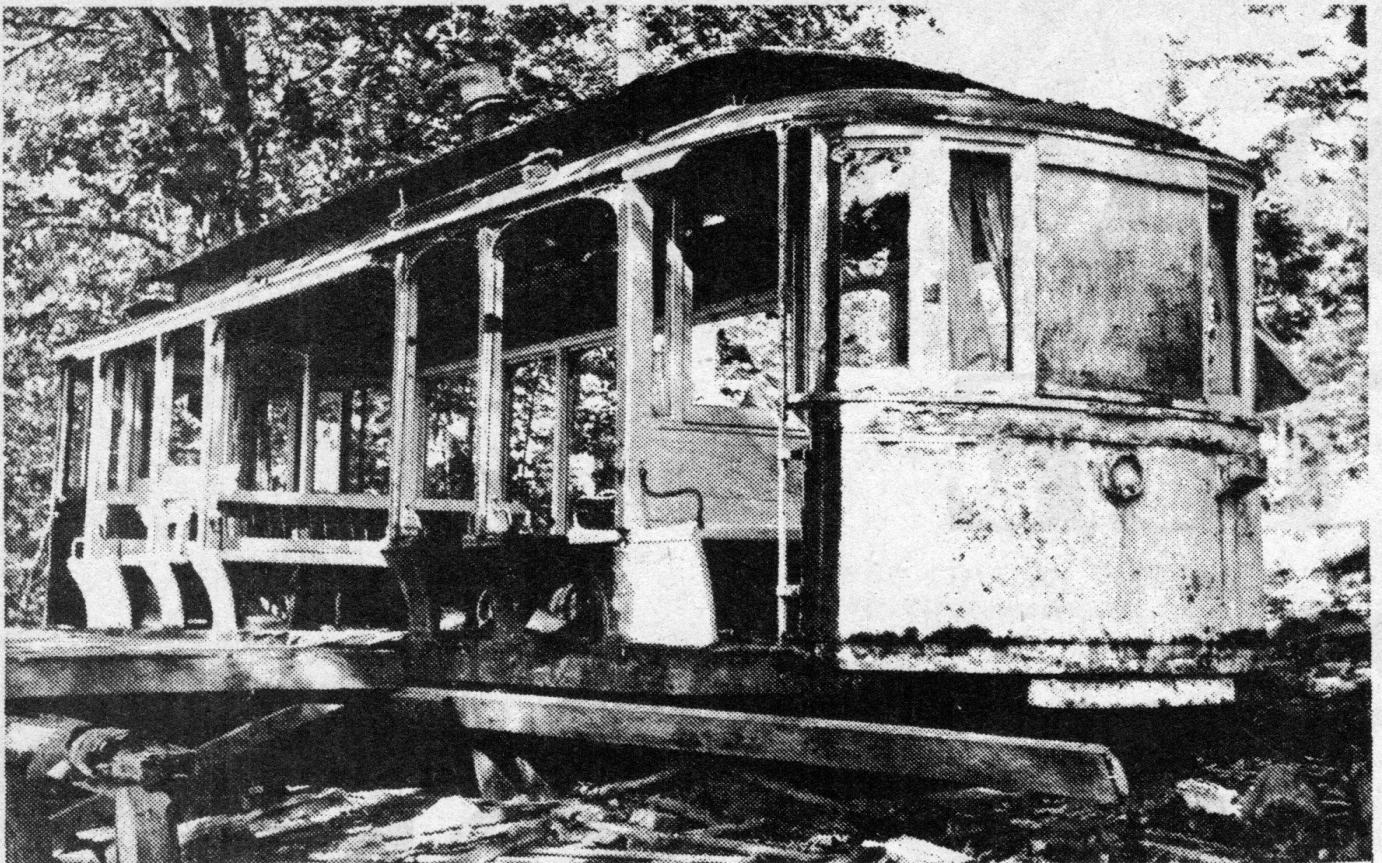
## Diamond Drill
