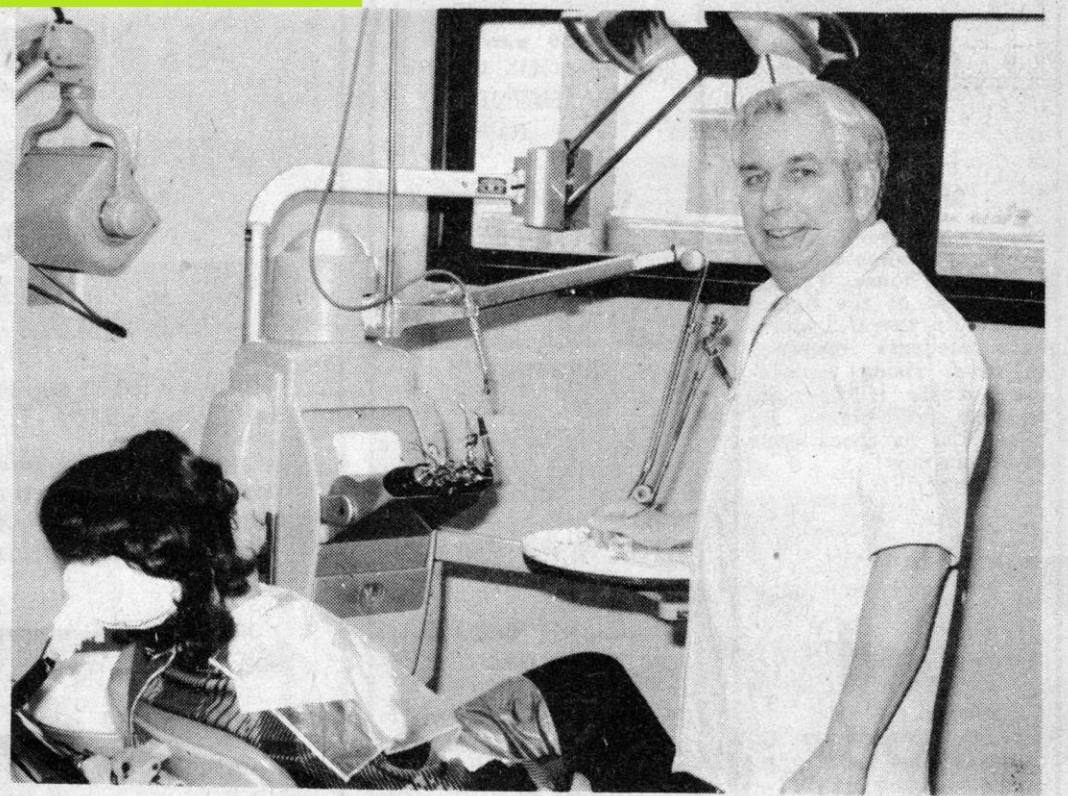
Out of the Past

Born and raised in Detroit, Dr. Frans saw service with the Marine Corps during World War II and in 1958 completed his studies in dentistry at the University of Detroit where he was a classmate of Dr. Paul Jacobs of Iron Mountain.
