Out of the Past

The Crystal Falls City Council has approved the extension of the sewer system to an area of the Western Location north of Garfield Avenue and west of Logan Street. The property is part of the recently platted tract that the City obtained from the Keweenaw Land Association. Crystal Falls City has been barred by Michigan State regulations from selling lots in the plat because of the inaccessibility of sewer service. Several houses exist in the area being built on leased property with septic systems installed and the existing owners will be required to hook up the new sewer service once deed transfers have been completed.

The fifth break-in in less than a year occurred at the Forest Park Schools and left law enforcement and school officials perplexed as to why the vandalism and destruction which may total over \$3,000 occurred. Some 20 individual rooms were ransacked with the intent of the perpetrators only destruction and creating chaos. Rewards have been offered for the apprehension of the guilty parties.
