The North Range Mining Company has dropped its lease on the mineral rights to the idle Warner Mine which straddles Crystal Falls and Hematite Township (Section 9 T44N/R33W). The mine first opened in 1915 and closed last year producing 3.4 million tons of iron ore from 6 levels, the deepest level extending down 1,742 feet. Hematite Township tax roll from last year listed the valuation of the mine property at \$375,000 and \$65,000 for Crystal Falls Township. The total valuation for the entire Hematite Township was \$699,147. Negotiations for the future valuation of the property are ongoing and are certainly going to adversely affect Hematite Township.
