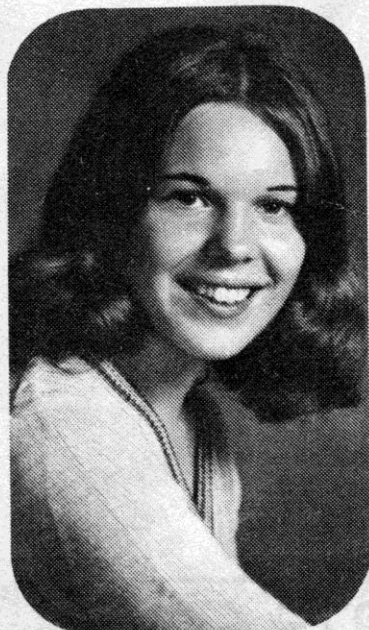


Junior Prom Royalty
