

Crystal Falls High School football reached its highest peak in history when the Trojan team closed out the season with its 15th straight victory and second unbeaten season in succession. The red & black under the direction of third year head coach Richard Mettlach along with first year assistant coaches Hartley Larson and Eugene Martino were led by 205 pound senior fullback Allan Stacy who claimed the Upper Peninsula scoring title with 125 points on 18 touchdowns and 17 points after. The defense was led by 175 pound junior linebacker Eugene Schiavo. In addition to Stacy, seven other seniors played their last game; Tom Addison, Ray Bartolini, Tony Ghidorzi, Dennis Perry, Art Puotinen, Jon Stoor and Ron Tirapelli. In recognition of the team's accomplishment a group of fans headed by the women of the Crystal Falls VFW Auxiliary raised enough money through donations to send the entire team, including coaches and managers, to attend the Green Bay Packers versus Philadelphia Eagles professional football contest in Green Bay.
