Out of the Past

The Michigan State Law regulating the taking up of stray horses, oxen or mules allows the person who has obtained them to work the beasts as their own after a period of 30 days by filing notice with Township Clerk costing 50 cents. The original owner may reclaim the animal within one year by proving ownership and paying boarding costs to the finder.

The City of Crystal Falls has hired John Shemky as night policeman to see that the laws governing traffic and City ordinances as well as ordinary laws of the land are enforced. Shemky has been given "carte blanche" instructions to enforce the letter of the law and is hoped that he enforces them without fear or favor.
