Out of the Past

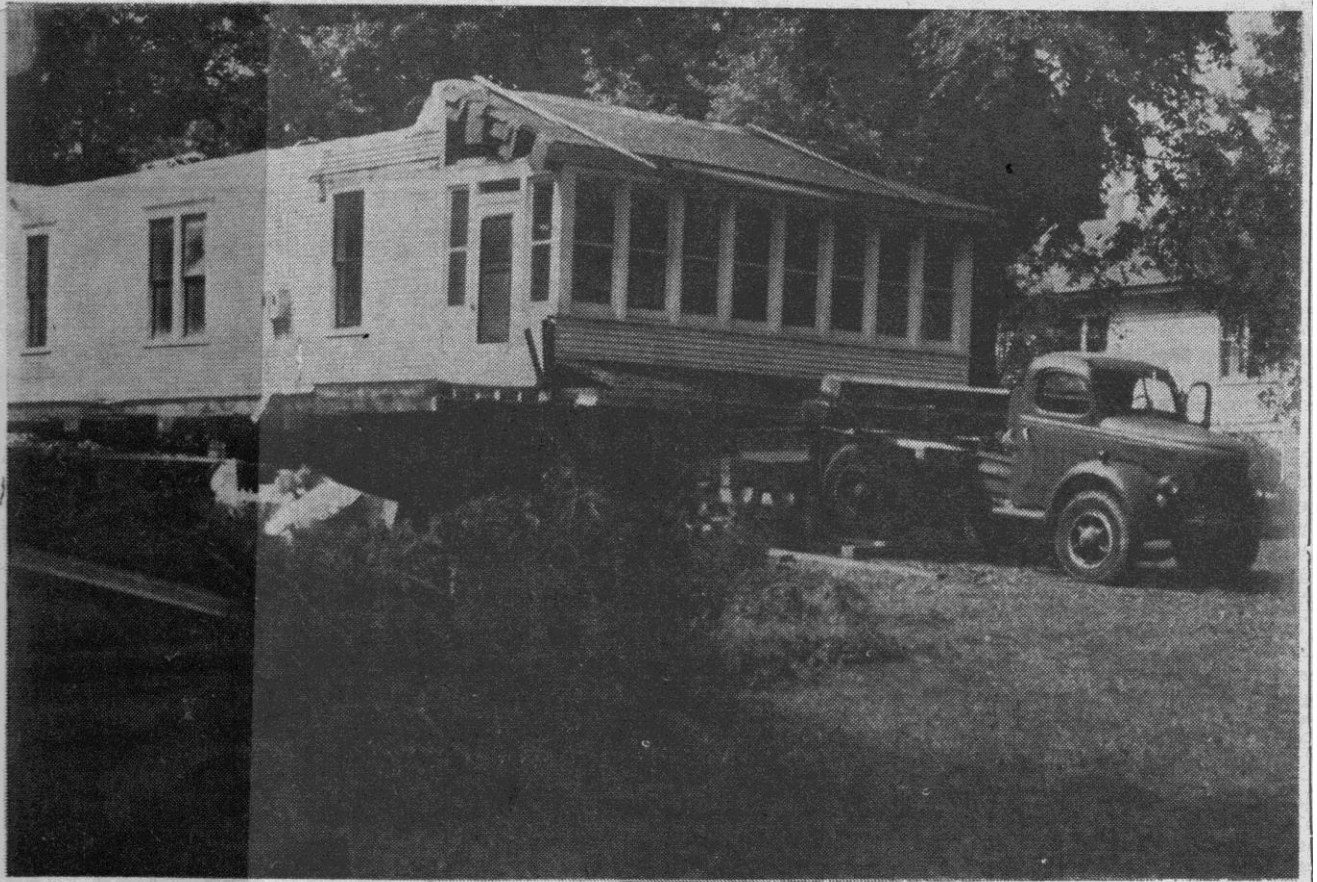
August 10, 1961

The former First Lutheran Church parsonage located at 12 Court Street, just north of the Iron County Courthouse is being partially dismantled and relocated to the Randville area by Robert Ballock. After the 25 mile trip the structure will be placed on a new foundation and convert the former two-story home into a story and one-half residence. The parsonage originally build in the early 1900's, was the home to a long line of ministers and their families for the Lutheran Church that was located on the southwest corner of Crystal Avenue and South 6th Street and the new Lutheran Church which constructed on Superior Avenue across from the Post Office in 1952. The congregation is in the process of building a new parsonage on the site hopefully to be completed this fall.
