Some idea of the importance of basketball as a competitive sport in Crystal Falls is given by the enrollment in the grade and high school level intramural leagues formed to be played at the Crystal Falls schools' two gyms. A total of 20 teams, each with a roster averaging seven boys per team will play into February when a playoff concludes the season. The 150 participants have six teams on the 5th & 6th grade level, eight teams on the 7th & 8th grade level and six more on the high school level. Five games are played at each of the school gyms each Saturday morning at 8:15, 9:00, 9:45, 10:30 and 11:15.

Volume 73 of the Diamond Drill Newspaper, which includes 52 issues, dated November 26, 1959 through November 17, 1960 will be placed on file at the Crystal Falls Community Library. It is the first volume of "The Drill" to be added to the library's reference section and will be followed by others at the end of each year of publication. Formerly only one full volume was bound and kept of file at the Drill office with only limited access to the public.
