Drilling operations for the new water well for Crystal Falls Township have been completed and the test results have found another outstanding source of good water. Layne-Northwest Drilling Co. of Milwaukee finished developing the 55' deep well, which is located northwest of the New Bristol Location off Lind Road (T43N/R33W Sec23), estimating a capacity of 2,000 gallons per minute capacity. The new well exceed the Township's greatest expectations and the drillers claim that this is one of the finest wells they have ever brought in. The Crystal Falls Township Board has also approved an agreement with Hematite Township to sell water to the Amasa area by connecting to Crystal Falls Township existing north water system located one mile south of Amasa to Town Line Road.
