

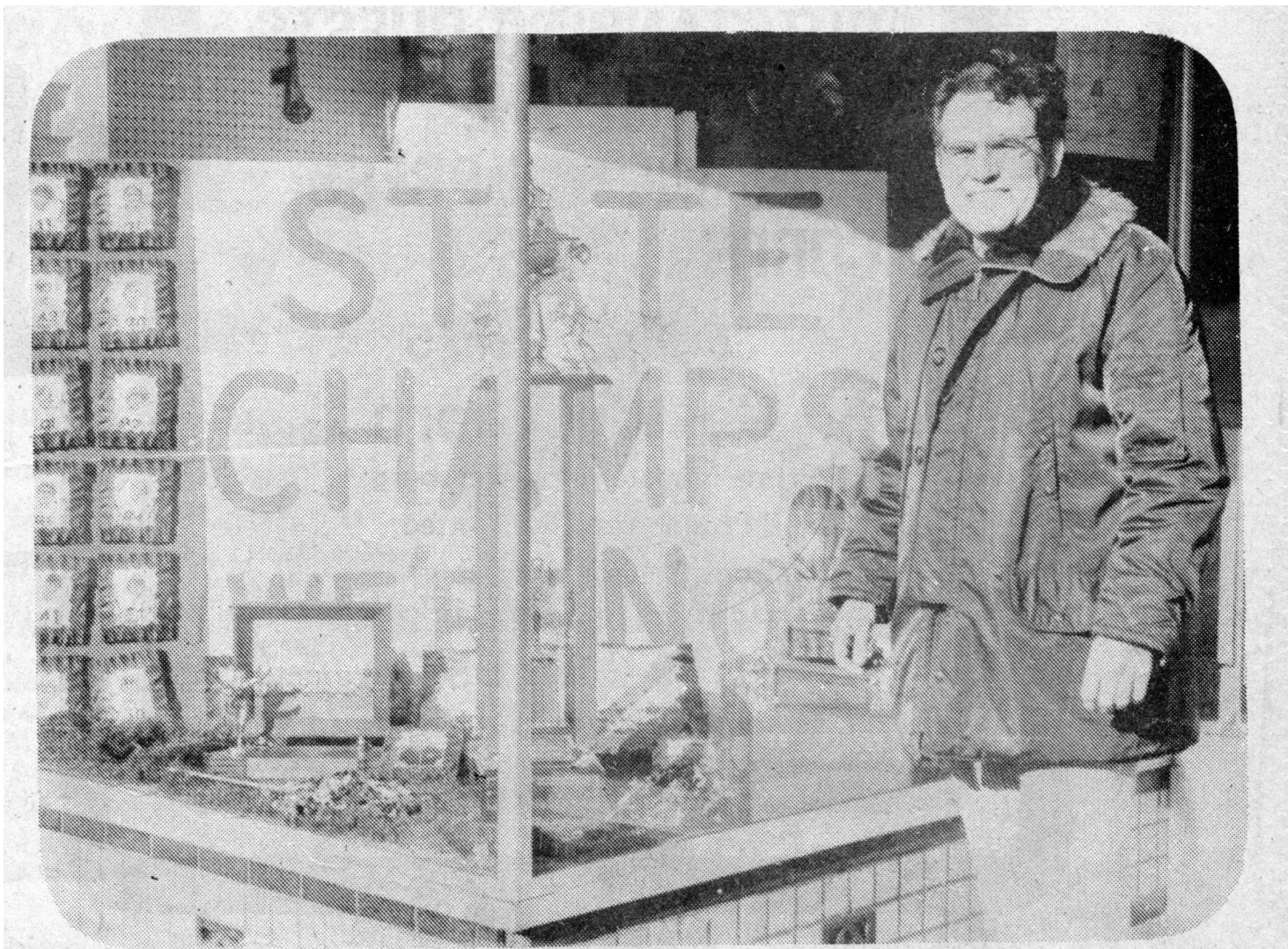

In response to several complaints from landowners in the Forest Park School area, Crystal Falls Township officials will give serious consideration on the banning of parking on all roads and streets from 2AM to 7AM during the winter months. The Board will consider an ordinance similar to the one City of Crystal Falls has enacted. The problem of parking and its abuses, especially in the school area has long been a thorny problem, more particularly in the winter months, hampering proper snow plowing by the Iron County Road Commission.
