

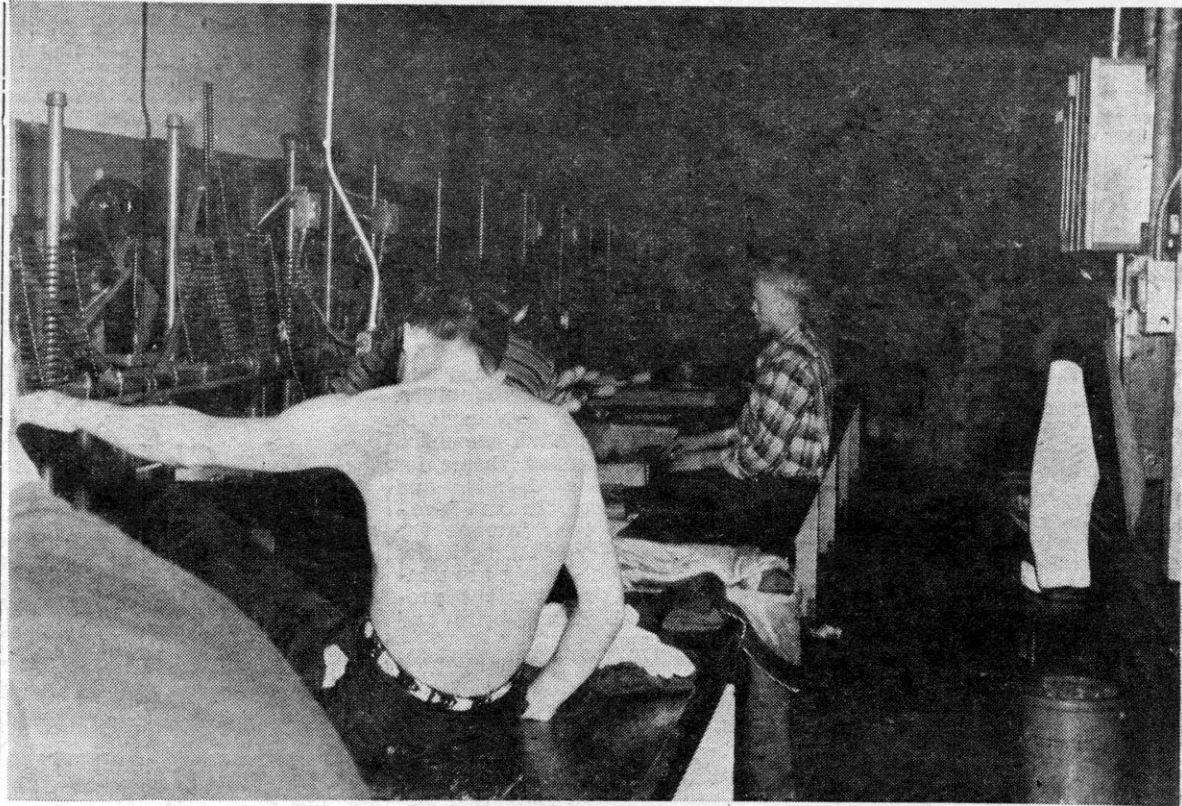
Diamond Drill

Out of the Past

The youngsters of the local area had very little opportunity to enjoy Crystella Ski Hill this winter season because of lack of snow. With recent snows the increased activity at the popular recreation area has resulted in a growing casualty list at the Crystal Falls Municipal Hospital. Treated for fractured bones at the hospital over the last two weeks were Darryl Salo (broken thumb), John DeAmicis Jr. (fractured ankle), Roz Bowman (fractured leg) and adult Walter Tuchowski (fractured leg).

To those who are rolling the ball, bowling is a source of relaxing recreation but to the corps of youngsters that man the pin setting machinery at the other end of the 70' hardwood lanes, a league or tournament event means about 4 hours of repetitious and tiring work. The pin setting machinery at the Martinson Bowling Alley (105 Superior) spots the pins mechanically by use of pin racks which are raised and lowered mechanically but the pins and bowling ball have to be picked up by hand.
