Out of the Past

A bronze plaque honoring Mrs. Christine Holmes and the late Mr. Holmes, will be imbedded in the concrete foundation for the flagpole to be erected on the property at the American Legion's on Lake Mary. The scenic property will be formally dedicated as Camp Christine in honor of Mrs. Holmes. The Legion will also enlarge the parking area of the facility. Holmes donated 39 acres of land in 1932 for the Veterans use.

The Crystal Inn (400 Superior) has on display a recently install mural. The 6' x 14' giant mural, done by a Chicago concern, is an exact replica of an old photograph of a railroad locomotive hauling a train-load of logs as it approaches a timber trestle.

An old diving raft at Bewabic Park on Fortune Lake with 15 years of service to its credit has been rebuilt. The old raft with its lofty tower had deteriorated with the planks and timbers rotting and unsafe. Iron County Park crews built the new 16' square platform with a sturdy tower not quite as tall as the one it replaced.
