Out of the Past

With the resignation of Dr. E.P. Lockhart who has been the physician in charge of the Pickands-Mather Mines on the west side of Iron County for the last 25 years will bring about a change in operations. Dr. Leslie E. Bovik, a Crystal Falls doctor since 1915, has been appointed as successor to Dr. Lockhart. Dr. Bovik who has had charge of the Alpha and Amasa company mines will supervise all medical and surgical work for the entire County. Dr. Robert E. White who is Dr. Bovik's assistant at the Crystal Falls General Hospital (410 Superior) will transfer to Caspian and take responsibility for the west Iron County. The Pickands-Mather Company medical staff includes Dr. L.E. Bovik, Dr. Donald R. Smith (Crystal Falls), Dr. James P. Edwards (Alpha) and Dr. L.F. Newbern (Amasa). Dr. Bovik's selection was made entirely on his merits by his work for the Company at Alpha and Amasa and was the logical sequence of events.
