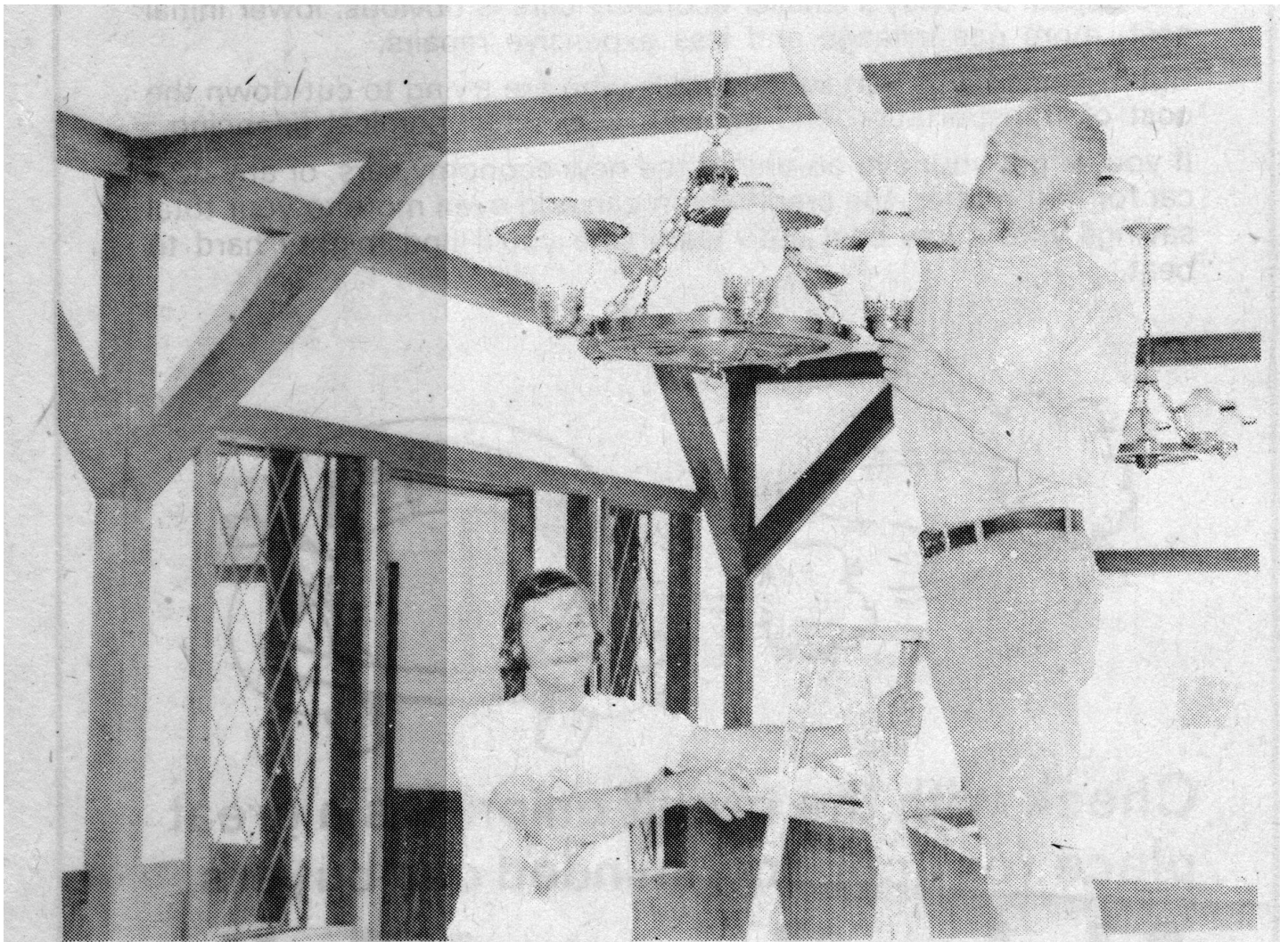
Out of the Past

Work has begun on the replacement of the roofing on the Iron County Courthouse. The \$70,000 project requires the removal of the existing slate shingles and flashings and replacement with regular asphalt shingles and sheet copper flashings. The work also involves some tuck-pointing of the brickwork along the eaves. The structure was original built in 1890.

The management of the Little Bohemia Restaurant (1344 W. US-2) has announced the opening of a second restaurant adjacent to their current location to be called Chalet Bohemia (1352 W. US-2). Owners Miro Pouis and Vladimir Jurcos, natives of Czechoslovakia, are completely remodeling what was the former Anderson Chevrolet Garage building into three separate dining areas all nicely furnished with new fixtures, tables, chairs and equipment.

Construction has begun on two new apartment buildings in Crystal Falls. Robert Sandona, who in 1969 built a four-unit apartment on the corner of Forest Avenue and South Fourth Street, will add a second building adjacent to his existing building. Jerry Aho is erecting a five unit, three story apartment building on the Northeast corner of Crystal Avenue and North Third Street.



A NEW RESTAURANT

What was built as an auto dealership, and did service for years as an auto body repair shop, is being transformed into an attractive new restaurant by a group of new residents in the community. Owners of the building, where a complete renovation is about complete, are the Miro Pouls and Vladimir Jurcos, both natives of Czechoslovakia. They presently operate Little Bohemia on an adjacent site on US-2 West, and will relocate into the remodeled building in about a month.
