A penny postcard addressed to the Michigan State Alcohol Tax Unit telling them that you as the head of a home wish to make wine for your own consumption will set the wheels in motion to give the "OK". The law allows the head of a household to make 200 gallons of tax free wine each year for home consumption within the home in which it is made. A permit can be obtained by filing forms and submitting to the Detroit Office at no cost.
