The City of Crystal Falls has approved ordinance No. 128 establishing a planning Commission pursuant to the provisions Michigan Act No. 285 of the Public Acts of 1931 as amended. The Planning Commission shall consist of the Mayor, City Manager, 1 member of the City Council and six members to be appointed by the Mayor with the approval by a majority of the members elect of the Council. The Commission shall make and adopt a master plan for the physical development of the City of Crystal Falls and its environs pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 285.
