Out of the Past

John Isaacson of Amasa was convicted of driving a vehicle while drunk in Hematite Township Judge Elmer Holmberg court. After receiving a sentence of fine and costs totaling \$50, Isaacson nonchalantly inquired if the Judge would loan him the \$50 to pay the money owed. Judge Holmberg unwilling to set a precedent for his fellow judges turned down the request and sentenced Isaacson to 60 days in the Iron County Jail.

A contract has been awarded to A.K. Proksch of Iron River to pave South Main Street in Alpha from the circle to the bottom of the hill for the sum of \$6,000. The work consists of grading and placing an 18' wide penetration macadam surface. The rock will be taken from the Iron County rock crusher plant north of the Paint River Falls dam with Engineering work and inspection handled by the Iron County Road Commission.

Crystal Falls Township is doing splendid work on West Superior Avenue west of the Iron County Courthouse. A rock ledge in the vicinity of the water tank across from the High School which has been protruding into the road is being blasted and removed.
