Fred Woelffer, 19 year old son of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Woelffer of Crystal Falls was taken off the critical list at the University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor after he regained consciousness for the first time after more than 48 hours since being involved in a two car head-on collision near Howell, Michigan suffering a skull fracture. The former Crystal Fall High School star athlete and present junior at Northern Michigan College, was enroute to East Lansing accompanied by Ray Neveau, Niagara driver of the automobile and Dave Blomquist of Felch to attend the Michigan State Iowa big ten football game having received tickets for the contest from Spartan star Dave Manders of Kingsford. All three youths are students at Northern Michigan College and had attended the Northern – Eastern Michigan football game on Friday night.
