An investigation is being conducted by the Pickands, Mather Company to determine whether the old Carpenter mine shaft located southwest of Crystal Falls can be recovered as an outlet shaft for the proposed mining of the adjoining Lawrence Mine property. The Carpenter operated from 1913 – 1928 and produced 2.7 million tons of ore. The proposed mining of the Lawrence Property, formerly known as the Wilkinson Mine, originated in 1920.

The greens at the Crystal Falls Municipal Golf Course located at the Western Location will be watered nightly during the months of June, July and August as a result of action by the Men's Golf Club.
